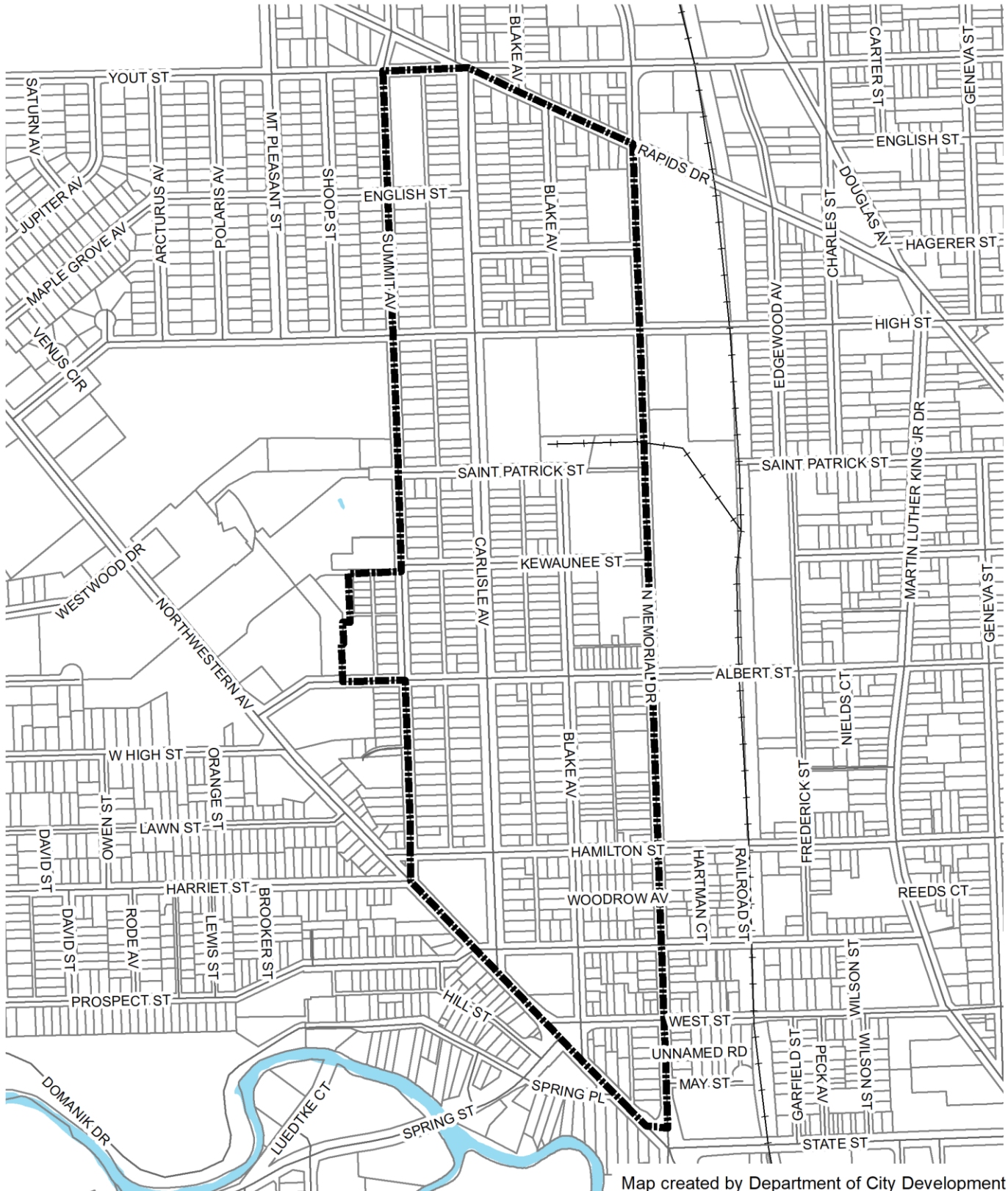

It does not result in any designation of any property on any register (local, state or national). The survey has zero impact on what you do with your property (that is regulated by the City Zoning Ordinance) and it has no impact on what you can do to the property. Any changes you make to buildings on your property are still regulated by the Building Code and Building Permits may be required.



