Re: Amendment to Chapter 94 of the Municipal Code. – Prohibited Turns

On behalf of Chairperson Alder Jones, DPW Staff recommends the proposed amendment to the City of Racine Municipal Code: Chapter 94 Article II – Specific Street Regulations. More specifically Division 5 – Turns, Section 94-91 – Prohibited Left Turns - Generally: *“When signs are erected giving notice thereof, an operator of a vehicle shall **not** make a left turn at any of the following intersections when proceeding in the direction indicated:”*

We would like to ADD the following items:

- (12) State Street, westerly at Wisconsin Avenue, at all times.
- (13) Washington Ave., westerly at West Boulevard, at all times.

In the same section (Chapter 94 Article II – Specific Street Regulations. More specifically Division 5 – Turns, Section 94-95 – Prohibited Right Turns on Red Signal: *“Right turns on a red signal at the following intersections controlled by mechanical signals shall be prohibited:”*

We would like to AMEND the following items:

- From: Douglas Avenue, St. Patrick Street and Marquette Street, east, west and northbound.
- To: Douglas Avenue, St. Patrick Street and Marquette Street, east, west, north, south and northeast-bound.

Please note that if committee and council agree, this ordinance amendment can take effect immediately.

There is no fiscal obligation for the City to amend the Municipal Code.

If the Committee agrees, the appropriate action would be to approve the amendment to the Municipal Code as described.
