Topics Discussed:

- Change of ownership. Christopher Miller is taking over his family business from his father. He has worked at the restaurant for the last 25 years and has had experience serving alcohol at the establishment. He indicates that he is not making any changes to the business operation, other than the slightly extended hours.
- Brief overview of licensee responsibilities. Mr. Miller has never held a retail license and will have to take the responsible beverages server training course. Attorney Arn provided a brief overview of the local rules and regulations as it relates to the establishment.
- New occupancy permit needed. Mr. Miller has yet to apply for and obtain an occupancy permit for the building in his name.
- Police department issues. Sgt. Ortiz will highlight police issues, if any, associated with the premises at the committee meeting.

Overall summary:

Sausage Kitchen is a family owned restaurant with breakfast and lunch hours. They will provide only beer to their customers. Although there is an official change in ownership at this time, Mr. Miller has been operating the business for quite some time with his father. Given the lack of issues associated with the sale of alcohol at this premises, staff does not have any major concerns regarding the license application.
