#### Thursday, August 4, 2022

**Rhino Bar** - 1659 N Main St - Civil Trouble - Bartender called to report three females becoming verbally aggressive in the bar. The bartender noticed three woman in the bathroom for an extended period of time. When she asked them to exit, they began to yell and threaten the bartender, at which time they were asked to leave. **The Brickhouse** - 316 Main St - Assistance Requested - An employee called police to ask for assistance after they escorted a group of people out of the bar for an unknown reason.
