We have received a State/Municipal Agreement (SMA) for State Project ID: 2703-09-02/72, Mt. Pleasant Street (Limits: Rapids Drive to Romayne Ave.).

The Municipality agrees to the following 2023-2026 STP Urbanized Area project funding conditions:

- Project design costs are funded with up to 80% state/federal funding up to a funding limit of \$216,800. The municipality agrees to provide the remaining 20% and any funds in excess of the \$216,800 state/federal funding limit. Any real estate, or utility costs are 100% locally funded.
- Project Construction Costs are funded with up to 80% state/federal funding up to a funding limit of \$1,278,266. The municipality agrees to provide the remaining 20% and any funds in excess of the \$1,278,266 state/federal funding limit. Any real estate, railroad, non-participating items, or utility costs are 100% locally funded.
