4th of July Parade on July 4, 2023

Resolved, that the request of Fourth Fest of Greater Racine, Inc., is approved closing the following City streets on Tuesday, July 4, 2023, from 7:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., to hold the 2023 Independence Day Parade:

Main Street from Shoreland Drive to 14th Street  
14th Street from Main Street to Grand Ave  
Grand Ave from 14th Street to 16th Street  
16th Street from Grand Ave to Racine Street  
Michigan Boulevard from Goold Street to St. Patrick Street  
Ruby Avenue from South Street to Shoreland Drive  
Walton Avenue, Romaine Avenue, Augusta Street, Wolff Street, William Street,  
Isabelle Avenue and Melvin Avenue from Main Street to Green Street

Further Resolved, that the Commissioner of Public Works is authorized and directed to communicate with the U.S. Coast Guard requesting permission to close the Main Street and State Street bridges to masted boat traffic for the period from 7:45 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and from 9:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. on July 4, 2023.

Further Resolved, that the Commissioner of Public Works, City Engineer, and Chief of Police provide limited assistance, in the interest of public safety, to implement this event.

Further Resolved, that 4th Fest of Greater Racine, Inc., shall enter into an agreement with the City of Racine including the following terms:

In the conduct of the 2023 4th of July Parade (parade), 4th Fest of Greater Racine, Inc., shall comply with the directives set forth in the City of Racine's extant Equal Employment Opportunity Policy.

Any elected official representing any jurisdiction including any portion of Racine County, Wisconsin, shall be permitted to participate in the parade without payment of any fee.

Elected officials participating in the parade shall be permitted to include any other person or persons in the elected officials' parade entry.

Elected officials participating in the parade shall be permitted to wear any clothing, or display any sign, indicating such elected officials' name and elective office.

Fiscal Note: Because the City is a co-sponsor of this event, there are no further stipulations.
