

Ordinance 0002-23 – Amendment to Section 70-90 Animals Prohibited.

An ordinance to amend Chapter 70, Article III, Division 1, Section 70-90 of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine, Wisconsin.

The Common Council of the City of Racine, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Part 1: Amend section 70-90(d)(1) of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine by deleting the words, “,subject to compliance with Municipal Code section 10-71(a) and (b) “Waste product accumulations,”.

Part 2: Amend section 70-90(d)(2) of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine by adding the word “Island,” in subsection (d)(2) after the words “Harris Plaza,”.

Part 3: Delete and recreate section 70-90(d)(3) of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine to read as follows: “On the Root River and Lake Michigan pathways, and where the pathways winds through the following parks, dogs are allowed on the pathways and up to ten feet into the park on either side: N. Owen Davies, Washington, Lincoln, Cedar Bend, Clayton, North Beach, Zoo Beach, and Pershing. (Note: Absolutely no dogs allowed in Colonial Park.)”

Part 4: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the City of Racine Common Council and publication or posting as required by law.

Fiscal Note: N/A

Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes section 62.09(8)(c), the mayor shall have the veto power as to all acts of the common council, except such as to which it is expressly or by necessary implication otherwise provided. All such acts shall be submitted to the mayor by the clerk and shall be in force upon approval evidenced by the mayor’s signature, or upon failing to approve or disapprove within five days, which fact shall be certified thereon by the clerk. If the mayor disapproves the mayor’s objections shall be filed with the clerk, who shall present them to the council at its next meeting. A two-thirds vote of all the members of the council shall then make the act effective notwithstanding the objections of the mayor.
