September 14 – 17, 2016	Child Passenger Safety Technician	Learn the process for correctly installing car seats	Three staff members were certified to provide car seat checks and educate caregivers on how to properly determine which type of seat to use and how to install correctly.
September 17, 2016	Convoy of Hope	Provide public health outreach to the community	Six staff members worked the event at Walden School providing Health Department information to the community such as scheduling appointments for clinic services, educating residents on health-related topics, and offering STD screenings.
September 20 – 23, 2016	STD Prevention Conference	Increase knowledge of STD prevention	Discussed the different burdens and challenges of STDs across the nation. Topics presented included STD prevention systems, adolescents and young adults, expedited partner therapy (EPT), antibiotic-resistant gonorrhea, and the resurgence of syphilis.
