
Dear Property Owner:

The City of Racine Plan Commission has received an application from Mousa Alfoqaha, seeking a Conditional Use Permit at 3425 Kinzie Ave, for a convenience/grocery store. The proposed merchandise is various household needs such as milk and bread as well as cleaning products, etc. In addition they plan on continuing to sell phones as they did in their previous store. They plan on applying for a permit for soda and cigarettes. No alcohol sales are proposed. Hours of operation will be Mon-Sat 10 A.M. - 8 P.M. and Sun 10 A.M. - 6 P.M.

The subject property is zoned R2 Single-Family Residence District. The specific location is shown as "Subject Property" on the map below.
