## City of Racine, Wisconsin Declaration of Official Intent to Reimburse Racine Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion Resolution No.

WHEREAS, the City of Rac	ine, and its Wastewate	r Commission, owns	s and operates a
wastewater treatment plant a	and conveyance system	through the Racine	Wastewater Utility; and

WHEREAS, local communities may need to expand the treatment capacity for future growth; and

WHEREAS, the Utility expects to obtain a loan to provide long-term financing for the Project from the CWFP; and

WHEREAS, planning, engineering and construction of the Project is expected to proceed prior to the CWFP loan being available; and

WHEREAS, the Racine Wastewater Utility wishes to declare its intent to use its internal funds to temporarily fund the planning, engineering and construction of the Project until the CWFP loan, or other long-term financing, can be obtained; and

WHEREAS, this resolution documents the City's intent to reimburse its internal funds, as required by Treasury Regulations 26 CFR 1.150-2, with tax-exempt bond proceeds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Racine, Wisconsin, that:

- 1. <u>Expenditures of Funds</u>. The City or the Racine Wastewater Utility shall make expenditures as needed from funds on hand, including funds in the Wastewater Fund, to pay the cost of planning, engineering and construction of the Project until the CWFP loan proceeds become available.
- 2. <u>Declaration of Official Intent</u>. The City hereby officially declares its intent under Treasury Regulations, 26 CFR 1.150-2 to reimburse said expenditures with proceeds of the CWFP loan, the aggregate principal amount of debt expected not to exceed \$60,000,000.
