## **REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY RESOLUTION 18-07**

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority owns properties that are vacant but not generally available to the public because of their condition and potential for redevelopment;

WHEREAS, the City of Racine Police Department and the City of Racine Fire Department do not have training facilities or spaces that are indoor, spacious, and secure enough for training;

WHEREAS, there are opportunities for interdepartmental cooperation between the RDA and the Police and Fire Departments;

WHEREAS, both the RDA and the Police and Fire Departments wish to work together to allow a space for training but want to ensure that both organizations are protected from liability issues;

WHEREAS, in buildings that are slated for demolition, both the Police and Fire Departments would benefit from training spaces where destructive training could be allowed;

RESOLVED, that the Authority supports the use of RDA buildings for training by the City of Racine Police Department and the Racine Fire Department where feasible;

FURTHER RESOLVED, the Authority recommends that the Executive Director is authorized and directed to enter into a license agreement with the City of Racine.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proposed license agreement be referred to the Finance and Personnel Committee of the Common Council for its review and approval.
