# **COMPLAINT UPDATE**:

• Complainant moved out of her apartment a day past the expiration of her 28 day notice. Landlord verbally agreed to allow her to stay the extra day, CP even offered money to cover her time, LL refused. Two months after move out CP received a summons to go to court for an eviction as a hold over tenant. CP was referred to Legal Action Wisconsin. The case was resolved and the tenant was protected.

### **SPECIAL NOTES:**

Staff reported no fair housing complaints in May 2018.

Staff participated in a Tenants' Rights and Responsibilities training on May 12, 2018. Staff specifically handled the fair housing section about how to recognize discrimination and what to do.
