EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: The City Attorney seeks Common Council authorization to represent an employee in the case of <i>Cobbs v. Chiapete, et al.</i> , U.S. District Court Eastern District of Wisconsin Case No. 2018-CV-338.
BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS: Chief of Police Arthel Howell is named as a defendant in this action that seeks a court order for the return of, and testing of, certain evidence from a criminal action occurring in 2003.
Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 895.46, a municipality is required to defend or pay for the defense of any official or employee sued for acts taken in the conduct of official business and to indemnify such employee or official if any judgment is ordered. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.115, the common council of any city may by ordinance or resolution authorize the city attorney to defend actions brought against official or employee sued for acts taken in the conduct of official business.
It is more efficient and easier to control costs if the City Attorney's Office simply defends, or manages the defense of, lawsuits against City employees than to have an employee pay for her/his own defense and seek reimbursement.
