Dear Mr. Yehlen, Mr. Eeg, Ms. Payne & Mr. Folstrom,

Real Racine, on behalf of the Wisconsin Senior Olympics, is asking for the city's permission to use a very small portion of Racine roadways for The Olympian 5k/10k on Saturday, August 11, 2018.

We are expecting about 200 runners to participate in the race. Nearly all the course for both distances will take place on the Lake Michigan Pathway and city sidewalks. We will begin the race at 9am on 11th Street, just north of the Gateway parking lot, and head east on 11th, turn north on Pershing Drive and immediately join the Lake Michigan Pathway.

Real Racine has been working closely with the Racine Police Department and the Racine County Sherriff, and now with you, to make this year's race a success.

I held a meeting on Friday July 13 with Lt. Dave Wohlegemuth and Lt. Shawn Barker to discuss the course and address any concerns by police and fire. No issues were presented.

Please find the enclosed courses for both the 5k and 10k distances.

We are asking for the city's permission to close a portion of the course roads for the race. I've also submitted this request to Mr. Palenick for Common Council approval. I am also requesting the use of cones to help mark the course at the indicated spots on the attached email from Lt. Wohlgemuth.

If you would like me to come and speak with you or your staff or council members at any time regarding the race, I'd be happy to do that.




