SUBJECT: Claim of Devonne Wilhoit, City Attorney File No. 2018-0228
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:
Ms. Devonne Wilhoit filed a claim with the city requesting \$500.00 for auto repairs allegedly arising while she was driving through the construction zone on I-94 between Hwy 20 and Hwy 11 on or about June 4, 2018. Because this damage allegedly occurred outside of the city limits, the City is not liable for these damages.
For this reason, it is the recommendation of the City Attorney's Office that the Finance and Personnel Committee recommend that the Common Council deny this claim.
BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:
Ms. Devonne Wilhoit, of 15014 73rd St, Kenosha, Wisconsin, filed a claim for reimbursement in the amount of \$500.00 for for auto repairs allegedly arising while she was driving through the construction zone on I-94 between Hwy 20 and Hwy 11 on or about June 4, 2018. After reviewing the circumstances of this claim, the City Attorney's Office contends that the City is not liable for this damage because the damage allegedly occurred outside of the city limits.
The City Attorney's Office recommends that this Committee deny the claim of Ms. Wilhoit because the City is not liable for alleged damages that occur on I-94.
