## **NARRATIVE & SCHEDULE**

JVA is a national association of Junior Volleyball Club Directors dedicated to improving the junior athlete experience by providing education, resources, advocacy, and events.

The JVA Midwest Beach Championship is the premier Beach Volleyball event for juniors throughout the Midwest Region. This event is typically held at Bradford Beach in Milwaukee but they have realized the need to bring the tournament to the best beach in Wisconsin- our very own North Beach. This is a juniors event (U12-U18) with boys and girls doubles teams.

The event starts Friday, August 2, 2019, with the JVA Beach Nation Coaches and Players Clinic from 1-5pm on the courts at North Beach. The clinic is bringing in some of the biggest, most well-known coaches throughout the beach volleyball community. The clinic will take place on the beach with skills and instruction provided to the players.

The actual tournament play will be Saturday and Sunday, August 3-4, 2019. Team check in opens around 8am and play will begin at 9am. All matches will be complete around 5pm.

## **EVENT SCHEDULE**

The schedule begins when event set-up starts and ends when clean-up of the event area is complete, all equipment is removed and the park is available for regular use.
