Dear Property Owner:

The City of Racine Plan Commission has received an application from Sam Azarian, the applicant, seeking for a major amendment to an existing conditional use permit for a construction yard at a multi-tenant property at 1535 High Street.

Specifically, the applicant seeks relief from the requirement to construct, with full dimensioned brick as approved by the Common Council through resolution Res. 0156-18 on May 15, 2018, a skirt on the office trailer, and wainscoting on the east wall of the adjacent main building. The proposal contemplates changing the specification to a cement board panel skirt on the office trailer and no brick wainscoting on the adjacent main building.

The subject property is zoned I-2 General Industrial District. The specific location is shown as "SUBJECT PROPERTY" on the map on the reverse side of this page (flip page over).

The Commission has scheduled a public hearing at which you can be informed of the details of the request and where your views regarding the proposal may be expressed. The hearing will be held on Wednesday, February 13, 2018 at 4:30 p.m., or soon thereafter, in Room 205 of City Hall, 730 Washington Avenue, Racine, Wisconsin 53403.
