Ordinance 0004-19 – Sec. 10-39 Animal Licenses

Part 1: To repeal and recreate Chapter 10. Article II, Section 10-39 to read as follows:

Sec. 10-39. – Late fees.

The city health department shall, in addition to the license fee provided for in this article, assess and collect a late fee of \$5.00 for every application for a license for a dog, cat, ferret or potbellied pig five months of age or over if the owner fails to obtain a license prior to April 1 of each year, or within thirty days of acquiring ownership of a licensable animal, whichever is later.

<u>Part 2</u>: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the Racine Common Council and publication or posting as required by law.
