- 2) The paint on the exterior of this building has deteriorated to a condition whereby chipping, cracking, or other evidence of deterioration is present. You are hereby ordered to paint this building per 18-312 (1) (2) (3) & (5).
- 3) The windows of this building are damaged. Windows must be repaired to their required condition by replacing all broken glass or deteriorated frames per 18-312(6).
- There are multiple nuisance vehicles on this property that must be removed. 4) SEC. 42-183. STORAGE RESTRICTED No person shall accumulate, store or allow any nuisance or inoperable vehicle upon any private property, per Sec. 42-183(a).

Nuisance or inoperable motor vehicle means any motor vehicle as defined in Sec. 42-181:

- (1) In such state of physical or mechanical condition as to be incapable of propulsion and constituting a nuisance such that the vehicle has an adverse effect on the neighborhood or city property values, health, safety or general welfare; or
- (2) Legally incapable of being operated upon the public streets or highways including, but not limited to, motor vehicles which reasonably appear to have been unregistered for more than 30 days.
