EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Giving to the Nations requests extension of its 2018 CDBG contract.

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

The Giving to the Nations Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) FY 2018 Contract states:

I. RETENTION OF SERVICES. The CITY hereby agrees to engage the CONTRACTOR and the CONTRACTOR hereby agrees to perform the services hereinafter set forth, all in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement to begin no earlier than **January 1, 2018** and continue through **June 30, 2019**.

Giving to the Nations has requested an extension of its 2018 CDBG Contract until September 30, 2019 to fully spend the 2018 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. Due to the delayed release of CDBG funds in 2018, which did not occur until October of 2018, Giving to the Nations will not have spent all awarded CDBG funding by June 30, 2019. Giving to the Nations will be using funds to pave a portion of the site located at its proposed community center at 1701 12th St.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

The total FY 2018 CDBG budget giving to the Nations will remain \$55,000.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Approve an extension of Giving to the Nations contract until September 30, 2019.
