

## 21<sup>st</sup> Street Name Change

Resolved, that within the City limits 21<sup>st</sup> Street between Clark Street and Wisconsin Avenue be renamed Caron Butler Drive.

Resolved, that there are very few properties (less than 10) that would have their address impacted by this change.

Resolved, that the ordinal numbered nature of the current name (21<sup>st</sup> Street) leaves little historical significance to the current street name. There is no person or event for whom the street is currently named.

Resolved, that an attempt was made to meet with all the property owners in the proposed area. Of the ones the City could reach, none objected.

Resolved, that an attempt was made to meet with all the residents in the proposed area. Of those the City could reach, none objected.

Resolved, as the property owner of the Bryant Center at 601 21st Street, the City approves of the proposed name change.

Resolved, Caron Butler is a native son who went on to be a professional basketball player, becoming a two-time NBA All-Star. In his youth he spent a great deal of his time at the Dr. John Bryant Community Center. He has always remained close to his hometown, hosting numerous charitable events in Racine for more than a decade.

Further Resolved that the City cover the costs for the fabrication and installation of nine street name signs, recording an amendment to the appropriate subdivision plat with the County, update various City databases, and informing outside entities of the street name change in the amount not to exceed \$1000.
