



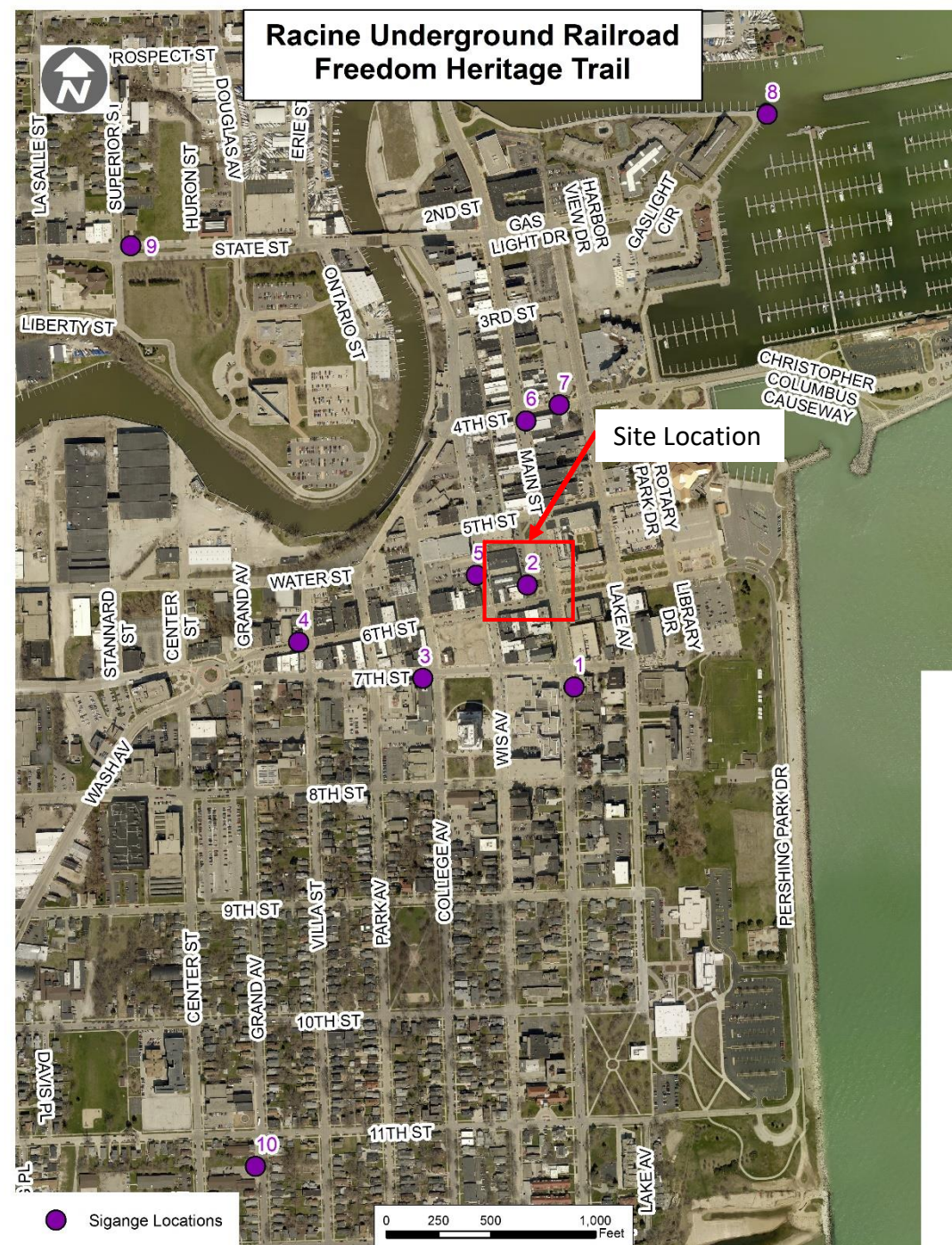

**JOSHUA GLOVER
COMMEMORATIVE MARKER**

DANMARKET SQUARE, DE. March 24, 1841. The paper stated that "the fact was established long ago, to remove the statue of JOSHUA GLOVER, a fugitive slave who had found safe shelter in Danmark Square, a residence of 100 who was a free, so the statue which Glover had been taken. This statue is the most well known statue in the neighborhood. The statue is usually carried to ship in Canada, when it is sent to London and to ship in 1841.

The statue commemorates Glover, and the statue is known who at their point, and one of their own one of the legends of slavery.

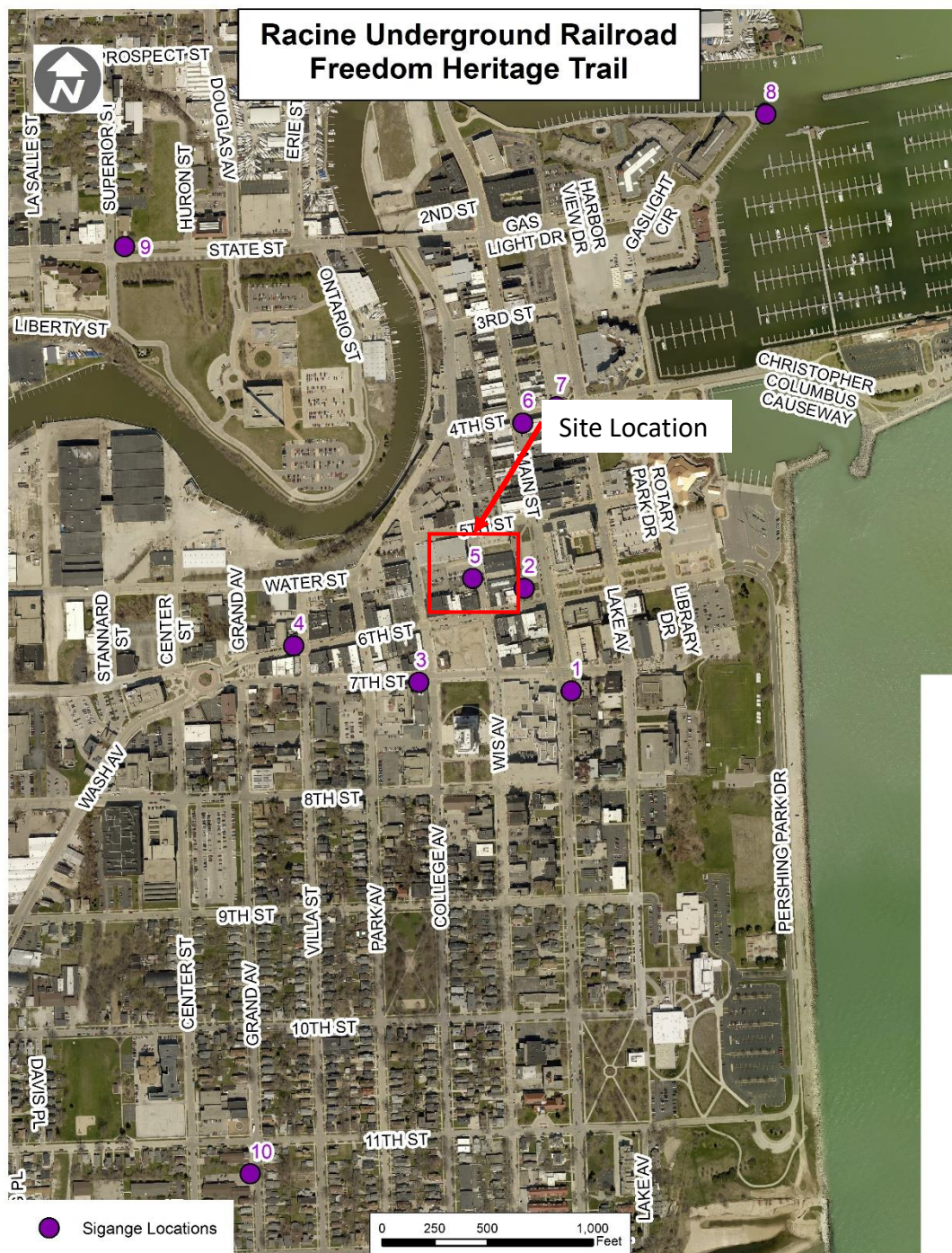

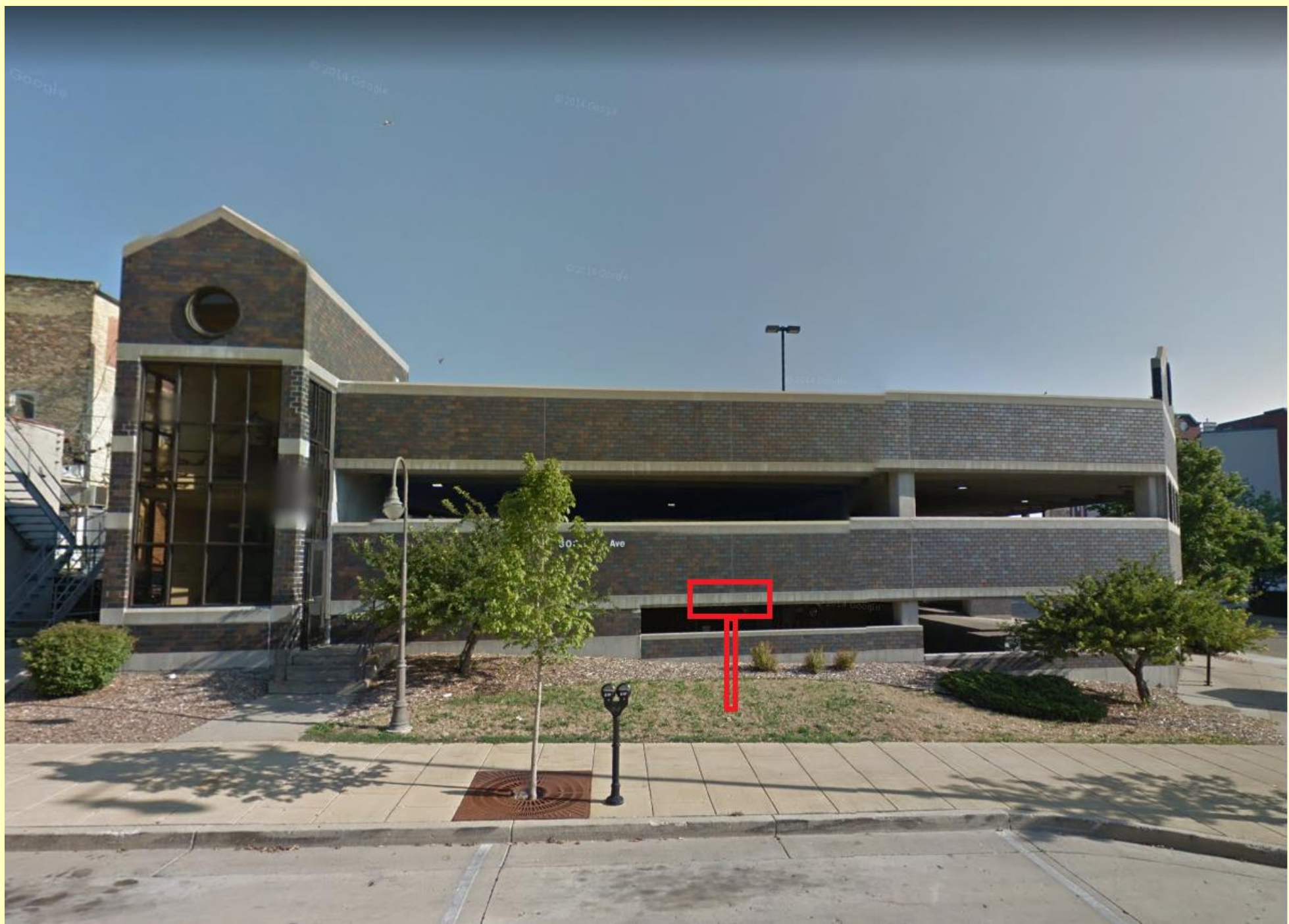
