Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Program and/or Healthy Homes Supplemental Funds

Resolved, that permission is granted to the Neighborhood Services Division to prepare an application to apply for up to \$4,000,000 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development related to the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Program and/or Healthy Homes Supplemental Funds, and to have the Mayor, City Clerk, Finance Director, and City Attorney approve the submittal of such an application.

<u>Fiscal Note:</u> There is no cost to apply. A City match of 10% would be required, which could be satisfied using the City's allocations of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. The Lead-Based Paint Hazard Reduction Program permits up to 10% of awarded funds to be used for administration purposes.
