The standard in Racine is somewhere between 11ft and 12ft away from the curb. The second image illustrates where I'd like to place the fence (the yellow line). The blue/red lines are where the Dan, the city inspector, said normally fences go but he doesn't believe there should be any issues why I can't build the fence where I would like it to be. Thanks
