BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

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- 21 LaQuinte Miller, of 2516 Northwestern Avenue, Racine, WI 53402, filed a claim for reimbursement
- 22 requesting \$2,188.28 in damages to his vehicle, which was parked on private property and allegedly struck
- 23 by a privately-owned vehicle on or about October 12, 2019.
- 24 This incident occurred on private property, specifically, in the privately-owned parking lot for the apartment
- complex located at 2500 Northwestern Avenue, Racine, Wisconsin. Both of the vehicles in question were 25
- owned and operated by private parties. None of these parties were acting as agents or employees of the 26
- City at the time of this incident. 27
- Because none of these allegations involve City property, a City-owned vehicle, or a City agent or employee, 28
- the City is not liable for these alleged damages. For this reason, it is the recommendation of the City 29
- Attorney's Office that this claim be disallowed. 30
