## Dear Property Owner:

The City of Racine Plan Commission has received an application from Dan Zignego of Zignego Company, seeking a conditional use permit for a contractor yard and shop, to operate a concrete and gravel recycling site with yard and concrete plant as allowed by Sec. 114-588 of the Municipal Code, on the southern 3.7 acre portion of the property at 1917 South Memorial Drive.

The yard and property would be active on a project specific basis generally tied to paving projects the Zignego Company would be awarded, and inactive at other times. The site would have anywhere from 1-4 employees at a time. The application includes using a tracking pad to control debris on roadways, and crushing machines with integral water lines for dust suppression, and a water truck.

The subject property is zoned I-2 General Industrial District. The specific location is shown as "SUBJECT PROPERTY" on the map on the reverse side of this page (flip page).

The Commission has scheduled a public hearing at which you can be informed of the details of the request and where your views regarding the proposal may be expressed. The hearing will be held on Wednesday, December 11, 2019 at 4:30 p.m., or soon thereafter, in Room 205 of City Hall, 730 Washington Avenue, Racine, Wisconsin 53403.
