The purpose of the public hearing is to provide the community a reasonable opportunity to comment on:

- 1. Creation of Tax Incremental District No. 24, a proposed district in need of rehabilitation or conservation The District will be created to provide for renovation of the existing City owned Festival Hall, construction of new convention space and development of a hotel. Proposed projects costs include payment of cash grants (development incentives) to owners, lessees or developers of land located within the district. The proposed boundaries of the district are depicted on the inset map.
- 2. Creation of Tax Incremental District No. 25, a proposed district in need of rehabilitation or conservation The District will be created to provide for redevelopment and development of buildings within the Horlick Historic District. Proposed projects costs include payment of cash grants (development incentives) to owners, lessees or developers



of land located within the district. The proposed boundaries of the district are depicted on the inset map:

- 3. Amendment of the project plan for Tax Incremental District No. 9 to subtract territory (Parcel 155-000) from its boundaries and to allow the district to transfer excess revenues to Tax Incremental District No. 24 as permitted under Wis. Stat. § 66.1105(6)(f)2.
- 4. Amendment of the project plan for Tax Incremental District No. 14 to allow the district to transfer excess revenues to Tax Incremental District No. 25 as permitted under Wis. Stat. § 66.1105(6)(f)2.

All interested parties will be given a reasonable opportunity to express their views on the proposed creation of Tax Incremental District No. 24 and No. 25, to include their proposed boundaries and project plans, and the amended project plans for Tax



Incremental Districts No. 9 and No. 14.
