RRP continues to work in the Uptown neighborhood, improving the appearance and encouraging partnerships through art projects, events, clean up, surveys, and resource referrals. The goal for 2020 is to repair and paint the facades of three buildings, and continue support of groups and volunteers in landscaping, art murals, gardens, and other projects that beautify and unite the neighborhood.



Supportive Housing Partnership

RRP received a grant from WHEDA for permanent supportive housing to enhance opportunities for people coming out of homelessness. RRP has acquired one property for rehabilitation and is seeking one other property for the program. Partnerships exist with local contractors and workforce organizations. RRP continues to build relationships with local businesses, organizations, and individuals donation to support this housing partnership with HALO and WHEDA.
