WHEREAS, on July 18, 2019, the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Racine (RDA), predecessor to the Community Development Authority (CDA), approved a façade remodel and façade design for the property at 1418 Washington Avenue; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2019 the RDA approved a façade grant in the amount of up to \$10,000 related to the approved façade design; and

WHEREAS, Racine Revitalization Partnership, the applicant, made changes to the façade design without the prior approval of staff, the RDA, or the CDA; and

WHEREAS, the reimbursable amount was based design of the façade as approved on July 18, 2019.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the amount to be reimbursed from the façade grant be reduced by \$1,000 for a total reimbursement of up to and not to exceed \$9,000 for eligible costs.

<u>Fiscal Note:</u> The applicant applied for and was awarded up to \$10,000 for a façade remodeling project at 1418 Washington Avenue. Because of a deviation from approved plans, the grant will be reduced by \$1,000 for a total reimbursement of up to \$9,000 for eligible costs. There are sufficient funds available in the façade grant program.
