

RWP COMMUNITY CERTIFICATIONS: RACINE WORKS PROGRAM

The City of Racine helps individuals from the community gain access to employment opportunities on the various construction projects in the City of Racine. Contractors bidding on certain public and private projects within the City of Racine financed with public tax dollars must hire a percentage of City of Racine residents to work on these projects. WRTP | BIG STEP offers a RWP certification to qualified individuals. Certifications become invalid if you move outside of Racine city limits and will need to update certification with the new city of Racine address upon moving.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Be a City of Racine resident
- Underemployed
 - · Laid-off for 15 consecutive days OR
 - Worked less than 1,200 hours in the last 12 months OR
 - Have 1040s from previous year to review eligibility
- Have completed a pre-apprentice program and/or currently hold an apprentice or journeyman status

YOU MUST BRING

Valid Wisconsin driver's license, WI state ID, or a picture identification card with a current City of Racine address

AND

- If your ID matches your current City of Racine address you must bring 1 piece of mail that was received in the last 30 days such as a current utility bill, cellphone bill, insurance bill, unemployment statement, bank statement, child support statement (non-junk mail) that matches your ID
- OF

If your ID does not match your current City of Racine address, you must bring 2 pieces of mail received in the last 30 days from 2 different senders addressed to the City of Racine address you are residing at such as a current utility bill, cellphone bill, insurance bill, unemployment statement, bank statement, child support statement (non-junk mail)
