EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

A budgetary shift between the Foreclosure Prevention Program and the Eviction Diversion Program

BACKGROUND & ANALYSIS:

CDBG-CV funds were allocated to Legal Action of Wisconsin to provide legal services related to Foreclosure Prevention and Eviction Diversion. The original budget called for \$100,000 to be allocated to the Foreclosure Prevention program and \$50,000 to be allocated to the Eviction Diversion program. LAW has requested to reallocate \$125,000 to Eviction Diversion and \$25,000 to Foreclosure Prevention.

LAW has found that the more pressing need is Eviction Diversion funding. The budgetary shift would all for the hiring of a full time staff attorney dedicated to Eviction Diversion. The CDC Eviction Moratorium is scheduled to end on June 30, 2021 and will lead to a greater filing of evictions in Racine. The shift in funds will help prevent evictions or provide dignified exits for households.

Legal filings for foreclosures have been limited and with other funds to help pay past due mortgages, this has lessened filings. LAW works closely with Housing Resource Inc. to monitor foreclosure cases. Legal services in the foreclosure process are not needed until approximately the 18-month mark of a foreclosure process.

Legal Action of Wisconsin has observed a great need for Eviction Diversion rather than Foreclosure Prevention.

The proposed budgetary shift is attached.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

Amending the budgets will result in no budgetary impact.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Approve a budgetary amendment of the CDBG-CV contract for Foreclosure Prevention and Eviction Diversion programs
