Thank you for the information. While ultimately respectful of the City of Racine's public process as enacted, I am disappointed that we will not get to plead our case. There is a lot of nuance and periphery to this application. There are two reputable developers involved--heavily in the case of Mr. Jeffers--whose opinion and expertise will not be brought to the table for consideration. There is a Seller who is being adversely impacted. In fairness, I would think the process should accommodate these constituencies as part of overall deliberations.

Is there an additional meeting, perhaps at a City Council level, where our public testimony will be heard? Forgive me that I am not clear if the commission is acting in an advisory or determinative capacity.

Should the commission be determinative in nature, I would at a minimum respectfully request that this email be entered into the public record. At par, I would respectfully request that a public meeting with notice be scheduled whereby we can all enter testimony into the public record.
