Ordinance 0011-21 – Offenders Under 18 Years

An ordinance to create Chapter 2, Article VI, Section 2-557 of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine, Wisconsin.

The Common Council of the City of Racine, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

<u>Part 1</u>: Chapter 2, Article VI, section 2-557, of the Municipal Code of the City of Racine is created as follows:

Section 2-557. – Offenders under 18 years.

- a) Bond Schedule. In the case of an alleged ordinance violation on or after August 1, 2021, by a minor under the age of 18 years, except traffic and boating violations, the basic amount of the deposit shall be \$10.00.
- b) Penalty for Violation. Any minor under the age of 18 years who violates any ordinance on or after August 1, 2021, except traffic and boating violations, shall, upon conviction, forfeit no more than \$50.00.
- c) Conflicting Provisions. Where there exists a conflict between ordinances for alleged or convicted offenders under the age of 18 years, this section shall supersede all else.

<u>Part 2:</u> This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the members-elect of the City of Racine Common Council and publication or posting as required by law.

Fiscal Note:

Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes section 62.09(8)(c), the mayor shall have the veto power as to all acts of the common council, except such as to which it is expressly or by necessary implication otherwise provided. All such acts shall be submitted to the mayor by the clerk and shall be in force upon approval evidenced by the mayor's signature, or upon failing to approve or disapprove within 5 days, which fact shall be certified thereon by the clerk. If the mayor disapproves the mayor's objections shall be filed with the clerk, who shall present them to the council at its next meeting. A two-thirds vote of all the members of the council shall then make the act effective notwithstanding the objections of the mayor.
