## SUBJECT:

Communication from Mayor Mason seeking approval to enter into amendment \#3 to the development incentive agreement with The Main Attraction, LLC, regarding the Verdant Hotel project at 500 Main Street.

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Since the amended agreement was approved in March of 2021 the City Development Team, outside council, and all of the parties to the agreement have been working diligently towards the closing of the financing for the project. During due diligence a few items came to our attention that are being requested in this amendment.

1. It became apparent that that the original parking language in the developer agreement would need to be modified to better reflect the needs of the hotel as well as work within our current parking commitments.
2. Within weeks of the anticipated closing, due to factors beyond our control, the construction company, and one of the financial partners for the project could not commit to the proposed level of funding. The result was a pause in the closing of the project while Dominion Properties worked to
secure a new funding source. A new construction company has now committed to the project with a contribution to the capital stack, but this has delayed the project by about 8 weeks, requiring an extension to our development agreement.

The amendment is requesting three changes to the original agreement:

## Parking:

The amendment from March 2, 2021, includes language to have 100 parking stalls allocated between the McMynn Ramp and the Civic Center Ramp. This amendment requests that the stalls be made available at the Civic Center Ramp and the Lake Avenue Ramp, eliminating McMynn. There is also a parking lease agreement that will be proposed to Finance and Personnel that will have the specifics on this arrangement.

## Financing:

The City's portion of the capital stack will remain exactly the same as the amendment from March 2, 2021 referenced: \$5.5 Million City Loan to the Developer and $\$ 2.895$ grant to the developer. A language change to the agreement is being requested to more accurately reflect how those funds will be contributed to the capital stack.

## Commencement Date:

The March 2, 2021 amendment to the agreement had a commencement date of July 15, 2021. In order for the closing to occur on all of the financing, the new commencement of construction date will be no later than October 31, 2021.

## CITY INVESTMENT \& BUDGETARY IMPACT:

With project costs of over $\$ 30$ million, the project is anticipated to bring at least $\$ 20 \mathrm{M}$ of new tax valuation to the City of Racine. This project will be evaluated by the City Assessor and will be considered "Net new construction"

## RECOMMENDED ACTION:

To authorize and direct the Mayor and the City Clerk to enter into amendment \#3 to the development agreement with The Main Attraction, LLC, regarding the Verdant Hotel at 500 Main Street.
