Dear Alder Jones:

The City of Racine has received Amendment No. 2 from AECOM for continued services addressing flow exceedances in sanitary sewer moratorium areas, particularly in the vicinity of Goold St. and Main St. The continued professional services will assist the City in developing plans for, and responding to, flow exceedances to the satisfaction of the Racine Wastewater Utility. The plan to mitigate these exceedances will ensure that sanitary sewer moratoriums will not be imposed for new extensions of sanitary sewer service for new development.

Services by AECOM in this regard include: evaluating storage concepts in the area of Main Street and Goold Street, assessing flow metering data in order to produce a preliminary design of a selected concept, and conceptual design of alternatives.

Amendment No. 2 to the proposal is in the not to exceed amount of \$19,917.00 and funding is available in Org-Obj 40101 52100. If the Committee agrees, the appropriate action would be to authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign Amendment No. 2.
