Municipal Clerk,

Please find enclosed Resolution 2021-51, which was adopted by the Racine County Board of Supervisors at their meeting on September 14, 2021. There are 21 districts in total and each district contains approximately 9,416 people. The next step in the reapportionment process is for the towns, villages and cities to establish their voting wards.

Section 5.15(4)(b) of the Wisconsin Statutes requires municipal clerks to send to the County Clerk, within 5 days after adoption of a ward plan, a copy of the resolution or ordinance establishing ward boundaries, a list of census blocks contained within each ward, and a map showing ward boundaries.

I believe all of you should have received information from the Legislative Technology Services Bureau (LTSB) with your login and password information for accessing the WISE-LR redistricting software. I have offered to work with municipalities that may want assistance in drafting ward plans. If you would like that help, and have not already called the office, please contact me to schedule a time to come in.

Some municipalities have indicated they intend to draft their own ward plan. For those that will be performing this work, I am requesting that the following naming convention be used when creating your ward plan(s) to distinguish between them:

## T/V/C (Municipality name) Ward Plan (#)

Example T Burlington Ward Plan 2

This will also allow us to be informed on the total number of plans being used across the county in the event we would need to contact the LTSB with the request for them to add more plan allocations in the software.
