<b>SUBJECT:</b>	Communication sponsored by Mayor Cory Mason requesting approval of supporting a grant application with an amount up to \$75,000 from the Wisconsin Coastal Management Grant for the Lake Front Restoration.

<b>EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:</b>	Mayor Mason requests that the Finance & Personnel Committee recommend authorization to apply for a grant for up to \$75,000 from Wisconsin Coastal Management.
<b>BACKGROUND &amp; ANALYSIS:</b>	<p>The Lake Front Restoration Project consists of restoring and improving the lakefront from Carrie-Hogle Park to Shoop Park.</p> <p>These projects are driven by a need to respond to wave impact and overtopping damage that were a result of the January 2020 storm.</p>
<b>BUDGETARY IMPACT:</b>	<p>Grants totaling \$60k or more require a 60% match, which would be up to \$45,000.</p> <p>Reserved funding available from the 2022 CIP.</p> <p>Grant Control #00405</p>
<b>RECOMMENDED ACTION:</b>	Staff recommends that authorization to apply for a grant for up to \$75,000 from Wisconsin Coastal Management proposal be approved and be forwarded to the Common Council with a recommendation for approval.
