Fiscal Note: The funds will benefit City residents with private lead service laterals. The loan is in the amount of \$500,000.00 and will be paid back through the Safe Drinking Water Loan Program.

He said once loan funds are made available, the Utility would reimburse the City. He noted that the Utility will make funds available to private property owners to replace lead service laterals.
