Freidel stated that when officers arrived the bartender stated that there had not been any incidents that had occurred inside of the bar and that the bartender had a very cavalier attitude and was not helpful. Ms. Scheibner told the committee that she had spoken with the bartender about his response and plans to better work with police in the future.
