	The General Manager explained that the agreement for consulting services between the Wastewater Utility and Brown & Caldwell with regard to the Island Park Grinder Pump Station and Force Main was being amended to include the design of the Grinder Pump Lift Station. He noted that the services performed under this amendment also include the development of a soil management plan (Item 1227-17). The compensation for these services total \$26,678.00, and the General Manager recommended approval.

Biosolids Management Contract and Authorization for the Wastewater

The Chief of Operations submitted Amendment No. 2 to the agreement with Synagro Central, LLC for the biosolids management contract to reduce the diesel fuel price adjustment from 0.5% to 0.1% for every \$0.05 change in fuel price, in return for a \$1.00 per wet ton reduction of the biosolids disposal fee. Other revisions were noted to authorize biosolids disposal to the added areas of Milwaukee and Walworth counties, and the correction of typing errors and party-named representatives. The Chief of Operations recommended approval.
