He explained that this study would help the Water Utility develop and analyze options for recovering costs for public fire protection. He noted a possibility of direct charges on Water Utility bills as opposed to adding the charge on the City of Racine's property taxes. This proposal is in the amount not to exceed \$20,000.00.
