# <u>0031-18</u> **Subject:** Public Hearing - Racine Environs Sanitary Sewer Service Area Amendment for the Village of Mt. Pleasant and Town of Yorkville - Mike Hahn and Dave Schilling invited to the meeting

### **Recommendation:** Receive and File

The General Manager introduced Dave Schilling and Mike Hahn from the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC). They explained that the purpose of this Racine Environs Sanitary Sewer Service Area Amendment is to add an area in the southwest corner of the Village of Mt. Pleasant which they wish to develop which is anticipated to generate an average annual sewage flow of 6.2 mgd. The General Manager noted that this item does not include the Town of Yorkville. It was noted that the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources would be the final approving authority.
