	Fiscal Note: All costs associated with the interceptor sewer relocation to be covered by the City of Racine.

The General Manager explained the need for the relocation of a 39" sanitary sewer interceptor at Racine Street and 6th Street to accommodate the planned Edge of the

River development at this location. He noted that the City will pay for all costs associated with the design, construction and abandonment of the 39" sewer to an agreed upon location. He also noted that the Wastewater Utility will continue to operate and maintain the new interceptor sewer. He requested authorization to enter into this agreement with the City of Racine.
