Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department Report

Tom Molbeck appeared before the Commission and discussed summer student help at the 5th Street Boat Launch Ramp. He suggested days and hours for an attendant to be on hand for the washdown station, assistance with the ADA chair lift and kiosk. He noted those hours and days would be Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays.

Racine Harbor Commission approved to fund half of that position, not-to-exceed \$2,000 in the 2018 season.

He noted the State Waterways Commission would meet in January to finalize requests of their funding schedule.
