Sean Brown moved that the Sex Offender Residency Restriction Board convene in closed session pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes to deliberate concerning the quasi-judicial hearing regarding appeal of Alan Bercklin for an exemption to the residency restrictions that would allow him to reside at 913 Center Street Lower Unit, and that the Board will convene in open session to announce its decision.
