Presentation by Barbara Farrar, Executive Director, LGBT Center of SE Wisconsin

Center started in 2009 to assist with issues surrounding discrimination, housing and work. Has expanded and now makes referrals for a variety of issues affecting the LGBT community. Have at least 5 walk ins per day. Bullying is a big issue in this community. Have a lot of young people coming to the center. Will have their annual picnic on September 9, 2018 at Sanders Park from 11-5pm. Have a prom for kids ages 15-18 years of age every year. Kids from all over the State come to the prom. Have anywhere from 60-155 kids attend. They are looking for a person to fill the Liaison position. This is a funded position. Also, looking for social workers willing to donate 1-2 hours of time per week to assist people. Person must have a Masters in Social Work.
