*Sean Brown moved that the Sex Offender Residency Restriction Board convene in closed session pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes to deliberate concerning the quasi-judicial hearing regarding appeal of John Otto Smalancke Jr. for an exemption to the residency restrictions that would allow him to reside at 812 Main Street, and that the Board will convene in open session to announce its decision. *Sean Brown moved that the Sex Offender Residency Restriction Board convene in closed session pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes to deliberate concerning the quasi-judicial hearing regarding appeal of Sergio Lee Mendez for an exemption to the residency restrictions that would allow him to reside at 912 Peck Avenue Lower Unit, and that the Board will convene in open session to announce its decision. Roll Call vote: David Younk Aye, Jessica Diaz Aye, Sean Brown Aye.*

*Sean Brown delivered the decision to grant the exemption, noting the Board applauds the recognition of and action to avoid potential issues with the neighbors at the prior residential location, and indicated the only issue the Board could spot might be with the prior and unrelated criminal record.*
