#### Fiscal Note: N/A

The Chief of Operations submitted Amendment No. 2 to the Caledonia Wholesale Water Agreement and recommended approval. He noted that this agreement involves a parcel of land owned by Payne & Dolan north of 3 Mile Road and west of existing Charles Street. Due to an expansion of the quarry, Charles Street will be relocated west. The water service to the Payne & Dolan property by the Caledonia Water Utility will be removed upon Charles Street demolition. The Racine Water Utility agrees to serve Payne & Dolan from the water main on 3 Mile Road to promote service efficiency and reduce cost. Payne & Dolan agrees to pay all costs, including the cost to relocate an existing Racine Water Utility metering pit to the newly created Charles Street. The Racine Water Utility will then bill Payne & Dolan directly for water service and sewer service. Payne & Dolan sanitary sewer discharges directly to the City of Racine sanitary sewer system.
