She was invited to the meeting to find out about strategies and techniques for finding suitable host families, but Monica was unable to attend.

Action on Dawn Imberi Memorial Gift – With the passing of council member Dawn Imberi, the Sister City Council made some decisions about monetary donations in her memory. We chose to pass along a portion of the money to the students travelling to Oiso this summer. The remainder will be added to the 20624-34500 - 10001 account to be used for similar student projects.
