Title: Subject: Communication sponsored by Mayor Mason proposing that the Common Council pass a resolution to place a referendum on the August 9th, 2022 ballot to pose the question of increasing the property tax levy for the purpose of hiring 11 additional police officers and implementing crime prevention initiatives.
